## Sermon Point (What is the main idea of our passage?):

Jesus possesses absolute authority as God and, as such, He has the power to forgive sins.

## Sermon Aim (What do we want the sermon to do in each of our lives as a church family?):

To convince us that perfect forgiveness of sins is found in Jesus alone; this is God's provision for every repentant sinner who clings to Jesus by faith alone.

- 5) Our need for forgiveness highlights the seriousness of sin.
