How do we evaluate a church? It's got less to do with any cultural concept of a 'successful' or 'perfect' church and all to do with the One who has absolute authority over everything, including his church: the Lord Jesus Christ (Matt. 16:18).

- c) Narrowing the focus from the universal church (true Christians all around the world) to something smaller: the local church (Christians gathered in one place/location).

- b) The Body of Christ (1 Cor. 12:12-31)
- c) The Family of God (Rom. 8:15-17)

3) Learning to Live (Practical Applications):

- 1. The church is essential to everything Jesus is doing in this world.
- 2. We must have a high view of the local church.
- 3. We must be willing to commit to a local church.
